1 About TWG 2025 Chengdu

1.1 About Chengdu

Chengdu is the hometown of the Giant Panda and enjoys over 4,500 years of civilisation history and more than 2,300 years of history as a city, manifesting a perfect mixture of history, culture and modernity. Being the capital of Sichuan Province, a central city in southwest China and a national historical and cultural city, Chengdu covers an area of 14,300 square kilometres and has a permanent population of 21.47 million, which has turned it into a megacity known to the world. The city has been identified as an important centre of economy, science and technology, finance, cultural creativity, and international exchanges in western China, and a national advanced manufacturing base.

Today's Chengdu values opening up with global vision. In total, 23 countries have been approved to establish consulates in Chengdu. And the city has established sister-city and friendship city relations with 114 cities around the world, and trade relations with 235 countries/regions worldwide. Following Shanghai and Beijing, Chengdu is the third city having two international airports on the Chinese mainland, following Shanghai and Beijing, and the 19th city with two 4F airports in the world. So far, the city has operated 81 regular international and regional flight routes, covering both passenger and freight services. In addition, it is linked to 123 overseas cities through its international freight train services.





Chengdu has been awarded the City of Gastronomy by UNESCO for its world-renowned Sichuan cuisine, great variety of delicious street food, and tasty spicy hot pot. It is also designated by UNWTO as China's Best Tourism City. Chengdu has successfully held the Chengdu FISU World University Games, the 81st World Science Fiction Convention, the Thomas & Uber Cup Finals 2024, the ITTF Mixed Team World Cup, and the Chengdu Marathon, among other major international events. Currently, Chengdu is actively shaping the brand of "A Park City Brimming with Happiness" and accelerating the building of a world-renowned cultural tourism city and an international consumption centre through cultural enrichment, business development, tourism promotion, and sports cultivation. By deeply integrating culture, commerce, tourism, and sports, the city aims to promote high-quality development, thereby writing a new chapter of Chinese modernisation in Chengdu.

1.2 Logo, Mascots and Slogan

1.2.1 Logo

On 17 May 2024, the International World Games Association (IWGA) and Chengdu ExCo officially unveiled the logo of TWG 2025 Chengdu. The logo design is inspired by the giant panda, hibiscus flower and Chinese knot, using the colours including Chinese Red, Jinsha Yellow, Park Green, Panda Black and Snowy White. As a crucial symbol of TWG 2025 Chengdu, the logo effectively conveys the Olympic spirit, showcases the traditional Chinese elements and the characteristics of Chengdu, and highlights the values of "Unity, Inclusiveness and Diversity".









1.2.2 Mascot

The mascots of TWG 2025 Chengdu are "Shu Bao" and "Jin Zai", modelled after two treasures of Sichuan-the giant panda and the Sichuan golden snub-nosed monkey. The giant panda is the best-known animal of Chengdu, and the Sichuan golden snub-nosed monkey is full of vigour and vitality. These two treasures are expected to showcase the image of Chengdu as a liveable and hospitable city and call on everyone to cherish rare animals and protect biodiversity.

The names of the mascots are inspired by "Shu Jin (Shu Brocade)", with "Shu" and "Jin" as the first word of their names, respectively. The second word of each name captures the well-known feature of the giant panda and the Sichuan golden snub-nosed monkey. The giant panda is known for its loyalty and integrity under its cute and fluffy look and is therefore named "Bao" (meaning "baby"). The Sichuan golden snub-nosed smart, brave, and bouncy. So, it is named "Zai" (meaning "youth").

"Shu Bao" and "Jin Zai" give expression to Chengdu's unique charm. As the ambassadors of cultural exchange, they will start from Chengdu, embark on a journey to tell the story of Chengdu worldwide and make the message from Chengdu heard by the world. They will bridge Chengdu and the world, so that the spectators from across the globe can enjoy the sports gala held in Chengdu while savour the city's infinite vigour and boundless glamour.

1.2.3 Slogan

It also conveys the hope that visitors from around the world can experience not only the intense competitions but also the city's unique philosophy of life and its people-oriented culture.

The slogan encapsulates the love for sports of the people around the world and their recognition and fondness for Chengdu. It embodies not only the fruit of collective wisdom, but also a shared





intellectual resonance and a thriving force that is commonly supported by the public, vividly interpreting Chengdu's passion for sports and its attitude towards life.






Figure 6 MMC Layout








Figure 7 MMC 1F

3 Sub-Media Centre (SMC)

3.1 About SMC

During TWG 2025 Chengdu, Sub-Media Centres (SMCs) will be established at each competition venue to provide accredited media with the necessary facilities and services for reporting on the Games within the venues. The SMC generally operates from 1 hour before the start of first competition until 1.5 hours after the end of last competition in the venue on daily basis. The operating hours may be extended due to delays caused by competitions, medal ceremonies, and press conferences.

3.1.1 Media Workroom

The Media Workroom will be equipped with desks with power outlets and wired and wireless internet access, televisions for watching live broadcasts of competitions, and INFO terminals for printing and photocopying. These desks will be provided on a "first come, first served" basis.

3.1.2 Press Conference Room

Press Conference Rooms are provided at some competition venues to facilitate interviews with athletes, coaches, and officials.





3.1.3 Press Tribune

The accredited media can watch the competitions from the tabled and non-tabled press tribune. Desks at the tabled press tribune, which will be available at some competition venues, are equipped with power outlets and access to wireless internet. Aside from reserved seats, other seats will be provided on a "first come, first served" basis.

3.1.4 Mixed Zone

The mixed zone will be located close to the field of play to facilitate post-competition interviews with athletes.

3.1.5 Photo Position

Photo positions will be set at each competition venue. Except for photographers from photography agencies officially recognised by the International World Games Association (IWGA) and TWG 2025 Chengdu, other photographers should use the photo positions on a "first come, first served" basis.

3.1.6 Media Lounge

Media lounge will be set at each SMC to provide a dining and rest area for all accredited media. In the lounge, both complimentary refreshments and paid food will be provided.

3.1.7 Results Bulletin

Printed results bulletins are not available during TWG 2025 Chengdu. Please check the results via the INFO system and print the results using the dedicated computers in the Media Workroom.





3.1.8 Video Shooting

Apart from the Host Broadcaster (HB) and Rights Holder (RH), no other media (including photographers from NOCs, NSOs, IFs, and those accredited as AS category) is authorised to live stream or record ongoing competitions in any area.




Figure 9 Xinglong Lake Hubin Arena Media Area Layout

Canoe Marathon: The Canoe Marathon features events of K1 Men Long Distance, K1 Women Long Distance, K1 Men Short Distance, and K1 Women Short Distance. It combines flatwater paddling with portages where athletes carry their boats over land. Courses are covered in laps with several portages.

Dragon Boat: The Dragon Boat sport originated in China and has been featured three times as an invitational sport in The World Games. It is recognised as an official TWG sport at TWG 2025 Chengdu. Dragon Boat at TWG 2025 Chengdu features six events, covering distances of 200 metres, 500 metres, and 2,000 metres. Each participating team consists of 12 athletes.








Figure 11 Xinglong Lake Hubin Arena Media Area (Canoe Marathon / Dragon Boat) Note: Photographers who need to take a photo boat should inquire with the MMC and the SMC.

Parkour: It is an emerging urban outdoor sport. At TWG 2025 Chengdu, it features four events: Parkour Speed Men, Parkour Speed Women, Parkour Freestyle Men, and Parkour Freestyle Women. In the Parkour Speed events, two athletes race simultaneously on two parallel, identical courses. The time from start to finish is continuously measured. The athlete with the shorter time is declared the winner. In the Parkour Freestyle events, athletes make use of the obstacles to show off their style and creativity within a set time.








Figure 13 Xinglong Lake Hubin Arena Media Area (Parkour)

Duathlon: As a discipline under Triathlon, Duathlon has a running leg, followed by a cycling leg, and then another running leg. In the Individual events, athletes first cover a 5km run, then a 30km cycling stage, and finally a 5km run. Rankings are determined based on the time taken to complete a race. In the Duathlon 2×2 Mixed Relay event, a team is composed of 2 athletes: 1 man and 1 woman. Each athlete will complete the short-distance duathlon, comprising a 2km run, a 6km cycling stage and a 1km run, for two times. The exchange is completed by the in-coming athlete, using their hand to contact the body of the out-going athlete within the relay zone. The team finishing the competition in the shortest cumulative time is declared the winner.








Figure 15 Xinglong Lake Hubin Arena Media Area (Duathlon)

Beach Handball: It is a non-contact team sport played outdoors in sand, giving a fine 'summer beach' atmosphere. In many ways it's like indoor Handball. On sand, players rely on quick passes and creative plays to score points, often with impressive acrobatic moves like jumps, spins, and alley-oops.

Beach Korfball: Korfball is a mixed-gender team sport where men and women play together. The objective is to score goals by throwing the ball into the opposing team's korf, of which the top edge is 3.5m above the ground, without a bottom, from any angle. Beach korfball is included in TWG programme for the first time at TWG 2025 Chengdu. Although there are some differences in the rules, Beach Korfball and Indoor Korfball are highly similar.








Figure 17 Xinglong Lake Beach Arena Media Area (Beach Handball / Beach Korfball)








Figure 18 Xinglong Lake Beach Arena Media Area (Handball-Beach / Beach Korfball)










Figure 19 Tianfu Park Media Area Layout




Figure 21 Tianfu Park Media Area (Sport Climbing)




Figure 23 Tianfu Park Media Area (Fistball)










Figure 24 Chengdu Sport University VOC Media Area Layout




Figure 26 Chengdu Sport University Sancha Lake Campus Boules Sports Court Media Area(Boules Sports)

Life Saving: Life Saving-Pool is a timed-measured sport, where athletes swim as fast as possible to complete the pre-defined distance. Some events require the competitor to swim underwater and surface with a manikin retrieved from the floor of the pool. TWG 2025 Chengdu features Manikin Carry, Manikin Tow, Medley Relay, Super Lifesaver, and Pool Life Saver Relay.

Underwater Sports: At TWG 2025 Chengdu, Underwater Sports features three disciplines: Finswimming, Freediving, and Freediving for Athletes with Impairment. In Finswimming, athletes swim with monofin or bi-fins either on the surface using a snorkel or underwater by holding a breath. In Freediving, the objective is to cover the greatest possible distance in a swimming pool by swimming back and forth in a single breath, with rankings determined by the total distance achieved.








Figure 28 Chengdu Sport University Sancha Lake Campus Natatorium Media Area(Life Saving / Underwater)

Flying Disc-Ultimate: At TWG 2025 Chengdu, Ultimate is played with mixed-gender teams, with each team consisting of seven players. The competition takes place on a grass field measuring 100 metres long and 37 metres wide. When an offensive player takes possession of the disc, he/she must remain stationary in that location and advance the play by passing the disc to teammates. If an offensive player successfully catches the disc in the defending end zone, a point is scored. A game is finished and won by the first team to score 13 goals.








Figure 30 Chengdu Sport University Sancha Lake Campus Athletics Field Media Area(Flying Disc-Ultimate)




Figure 34 Chengdu No. 7 High School Eastern Campus Athletics Field Media Area(American Football)




Figure 35 Sancha Lake Water Sports VOC Media Area Layout

Wakeboard: It is a water sport where athletes ride on a wakeboard equipped with fixed foot bindings, being towed by a motorboat via a harness. Athletes need to perform high-difficulty tricks, such as inverts and grabs.

Wake Surf: In a Wake Surf competition, a rider trails behind a boat, riding the boat's wake. After getting up on the wake, typically by use of a tow rope, the wakesurfer drops the rope and rides the steep face below the wave's peak, as in surfing, for at least 45 seconds. Riders score points in three categories: Execution, Intensity and Composition.




Figure 41 Sancha Lake Taohuadao Arena Media Area (Cable Waterboard)




Figure 44 Eastern New Area Orienteering Venue 2 Media Area (Orienteering)






Figure 52 Hi-tech Zone Sports Centre Public Fitness Gymnasium Media Area (Squash) Note: Due to the limited photo positions in each FOP, photographers are requested to consult the SMC in advance. During the competition, photographers in the FOP are not allowed to move around or change the photo positions.




Figure 56 Guixi Park (East) Media Area (Flying Disc-Disc Golf)




Figure 57 Chengbei Gymnasium Media Area Layout




Figure 60 Chengbei Gymnasium Media Area Layout 2F(Breaking)




Figure 61 Sichuan Gymnasium Media Area Layout




Figure 63 Sichuan Gymnasium Media Area (Muaythai)





Figure 65 Sichuan Gymnasium Media Area (Kickboxing)




Figure 66 Dong' an Lake Sports Park Multi-Function Gymnasium Media Area Layout




Figure 69 Dong' an Lake Sports Park Multi-Function Gymnasium Media Area 2F(Cheerleading/Aerobic Gymnastics)

A pass on the Trampoline Double Mini is characterised by high, continuous rhythmic feet-to-feet rotational jumping elements, without hesitation or intermediate straight bounces. Trampoline Tumbling is characterised by continuous speedy, rhythmic hand (s)-to-feet, and feet-to-feet, rotational jumping elements without hesitation or intermediate steps.








Figure 72 Dong' an Lake Sports Park Multi-Function Gymnasium Media Area 2F(Acrobatic Gymnastics/Trampoline Gymnastics)




Figure 74 Dong' an Lake Sports Park Athletics Media Area (Drone Sports)




Figure 76 Dong' an Lake Sports Park Central Square Media Area (Tug of War)




Figure 78 Qinglong Lake Park Media Area Layout (Target)




Figure 79 Qinglong Lake Park Media Area Layout (Field)




Figure 81 Longquan High School Gymnasium Media Area Layout








Figure 82 Longquan High School Gymnasium Media Area (Indoor Korfball)




Figure 84 Xindu Better City Softball Arena Media Area (Baseball-Softball)




Figure 87 Chengdu Roller Sports Centre Media Area 1F








Figure 88 Chengdu Roller Sports Centre Media Area 3F




Figure 90 Chengdu Roller Sports Centre Media Area (Speed Skating-Track)








Figure 91 Chengdu Roller Sports Centre Media Area (Speed Skating-Road)




Figure 93 Chengdu Roller Sports Centre Media Area (Inline Freestyle)




Figure 94 Chengdu Roller Sports Centre Media Area (Inline Hockey)




Figure 96 Jianyang Cultural and Sports Centre Natatorium Media Area Layout








Figure 97 Jianyang Cultural and Sports Centre Natatorium Media Area (Canoe Polo) Note: During the competition, photographers in the FOP are not allowed to move around or change the photo positions.

Jiu-Jitsu: It highlights clever use of tactics during combat and the use of techniques rather than brute strength. It is a "defensive art" for protecting oneself and others. Athletes must wear white gis and compete on a mat measuring 12 metres by 12 metres. TWG 2025 Chengdu features four disciplines: Duo, Fighting, Jiu-Jitsu (Ne-Waza), and Duo for Athletes with Impairment.

Karate: It is a martial art that primarily features punching, kicking, knee strikes, elbow strikes and open-hand techniques. Disciplines at TWG 2025 Chengdu include Kata and Kumite. In Kata, athletes stand alone in the arena, doing a formalised sequence of movements (a "kata") which represent offensive and defensive postures. These movements target a virtual opponent. In Kumite, two karatekas face each other. Competitors can use punches, kicks or takedowns against their opponents.

Sambo: It is a mixed martial arts sport, performed mostly indoors on a Sambo mat. The sport is a unique mix of combat sports and martial arts of the world. Combat Sambo is a practical contact competition, with each bout lasting five minutes. Athletes score points by executing technical actions such as strikes, kicks, throws, headbutts, and hold-downs.








Figure 100 Jianyang Cultural and Sports Centre Gymnasium Media Area Layout








Figure 101 Jianyang Cultural and Sports Centre Gymnasium Media Area (Ju-Jitsu / Karate / Sambo)

3.4.3 Access Policy for Opening and Closing Ceremonies

Accredited media who have been invited to attend the opening and closing ceremonies must hold their Accreditation Cards and a Supplementary Pass.

The list of media invited to attend the opening and closing ceremonies will be jointly decided by IWGA and Chengdu ExCo.h.

3.4.4 Transportation for Opening and Closing Ceremonies

On the days of the opening and closing ceremonies, Chengdu ExCo will provide dedicated transportation services for media attending the ceremonies. Shuttles will operate between MMC and the venues. The specific schedules will be released before the ceremonies.

3.4.5 Media Facilities at Venues of Opening and Closing Ceremonies

In the SMCs at venues of opening and closing ceremonies, there are operational areas such as Media Workroom, Media Lounge, Press Tribune, and Photo Positions.





4 Photo Services

4.1 Photo Services and Photographers

During TWG 2025 Chengdu, photo services will be provided for accredited photographers at MMC and all competition venues to assist them in taking photos of the highlights. For information regarding photo positions at each venue, please refer to Section 3, "Sub-Media Centre (SMC)".

Photographers from NOCs/NSOs and IFs must follow the photography policies stipulated in this section, just as accredited photographers do.

4.1.1 Technical Support Hotline

Photographers must personally complete and sign a Photographer Undertaking before collecting their photo vests.

4.1.2 Supplementary Access Control Device (SACD)

Photographers can collect SACD, namely, the photo vest, at MMC with their Accreditation Cards. The photo vests must be collected and held in person by accredited photographers and cannot be collected by others or transferred to a third-party user. In principle, photo vests will not be replaced if lost.

Photographers must wear their Accreditation Cards and photo vests to access photo positions in the competition venues.





In some competition venues, limited POOL photo positions are reserved for photographers from photography agencies officially recognised by IWGA and Chengdu ExCo. They need to wear a POOL photo vest to gain access to the POOL photo positions.

4.2 Briefing for Photographers

Before the opening and closing ceremonies, Photo Services Team will introduce the photography operations and services for the opening and closing ceremonies to accredited photographers. The time and place of the briefing will be published at MMC.

4.3 Photo Services at Main Press **Centre**

The Media Workroom, located on the first floor of MMC, will provide complete facilities and services for photographers. For





more information on MMC, please refer to Section 2, "Main Media Centre (MMC)".

4.4 Photo Services at Competition Venues

4.4.1 Photo Position

To facilitate photographers in capturing the wonderful moments of TWG 2025 Chengdu, photo positions are set in each competition venue.

All photo positions except those reserved for POOL photographers are provided on a "first come, first served" basis.

Since some photo positions are close to FOP, photographers can only enter and leave the positions at designated times. They can only change the photo positions in FOP during breaks in the competition.

Photographers should not obstruct the view of other journalists when shooting from the press tribune.

4.4.2 POOL Photo Position

There are POOL photo positions at some competition venues. These positions are available only for photography agencies officially recognised by IWGA and Chengdu ExCo. Photographers must wear the POOL photo vests when shooting at these positions.

4.4.3 Photography of Award Ceremony

Most medal ceremonies will be held in FOP, and only a limited number of photographers will be permitted to enter this area to take photos. If any accredited photographer wishes to cover the medal ceremony, please contact the Venue Media Operations Team in advance.





4.4.4 Application and Installation of Remote-Control **Cameras**

Some competition venues allow photographers to install remote-control cameras; however, in principle, only photography agencies officially recognised by IWGA and Chengdu ExCo are permitted to do so. Applications for the installation of remote-control cameras must be submitted in advance to Photo Services Team at MMC. Photographers must bring their own certified camera installation equipment and ensure that the installation is safe, stable, and reliable. They should also assume full responsibility for any damage to or loss of the cameras. The Photo Services Team has the authority to determine whether the remote-control camera installation is safe.

The installation of remote-control cameras within FOP must follow international practices for each sport, and the installation and removal can only take place during breaks in the competition and under the supervision of the venue media operations staff.

4.4.5 Application and Installation of Catwalk Remote **Control Cameras**

At TWG 2025 Chengdu, only remote-control cameras are allowed to be installed on catwalks. In principle, only photography agencies officially recognised by IWGA and Chengdu ExCo are permitted to do so. Catwalk remote-control cameras are only allowed in some venues. Photographers should submit an application for the installation of such cameras to the Photo Services Team at MMC before the competition. At competition venues, photographers need to submit a catwalk remote-control camera installation plan to the Venue Media Operations Team 24 hours in advance and sign the relevant agreements.

The catwalk remote-control cameras must be installed according to the most stringent safety standards: (1) photographers are only





allowed to install and remove the cameras at the designated times at each competition venue; (2) photographers must enter and exit the catwalk only when they are accompanied by venue media staff; (3) before entering the catwalk, photographers must remove any items that could potentially fall; and (4) the Photo Services Team and the media staff at each competition venue will confirm the installation of catwalk remote-control cameras and have the authority to cancel any non-compliant installations or those deemed a safety hazard.

The installation of underwater remote-control cameras requires an application in advance at MMC. Photographers intending to install such cameras must hold a diving certificate recognised by the Professional Association of Diving Instructors (PADI) and must provide their own certified self-contained underwater breathing apparatus (SCUBA).

4.4.6 Photography Notes

During the competition, flashing lights or strobe devices are prohibited in all competition venues.

Photographers are not allowed to use tripods at any photo position; however, monopods can be used.

Step ladders are not permitted at any photo position.

Photographers are not allowed to secure photo positions by using photography equipment or bags, and they must take all belongings with them when they leave the photo positions.

Large camera cases or suitcases are not permitted in the photo positions and should be stored in the Media Workroom.

Due to the proximity to FOP, photographers should abide by the dress code, avoiding unusual attire or any clothing with prominent advertising logos.

Photo vests should be worn at all times in competition venues.





5 Information Services

5.1 Overview

The INFO team will serve as the "official news agency" for TWG 2025 Chengdu, providing accredited media with information services, including text and images in both Chinese and English to assist them in completing their interviews. However, the provided information must not be used for commercial purposes

5.2 Content

INFO content for TWG 2025 Chengdu covers daily competition information, as well as details about the opening and closing ceremonies and other major events. The information is categorised as follows:

Background information: Information about TWG 2025 Chengdu, competition venues, sports, and participating teams.

Sports information: Competition Schedule, format and competition rules, results, athletes lists, statistics, etc.

Sports news: Previews and reviews, flash quotes, summaries of important press conferences, and media announcements.

Medal table: Overall medal table, daily medal table, and sport-specific medal table.

Opening and closing ceremonies: Schedule, information, and news





regarding the opening and closing ceremonies.

General news: News on sports, information from the host city, details about major activities held during TWG 2025 Chengdu, etc.

5.3 Services Access

Media can get the services through the INFO system link on the homepage of the TWG 2025 Chengdu official website, logging in with their Accreditation Cards number and initial password (the user name is the first seven digits of the accreditation card number, the initial password is the last six digits of the Accreditation Cards number and can be modified after the first login). Once authenticated, users will enter the system homepage. Following the homepage menu, they can browse, download, and use all text, images, and other materials provided by the system free of charge.

6 Media Services

6.1 Accreditation

6.1.1 Accreditation Card and Special Passes

6111 Accreditation Card

The Accreditation Card is the official credential for TWG 2025 Chengdu, used to identify the holder's role and corresponding access rights. Cardholders must wear their Accreditation Cards at all times in venues or areas as required. Holding an Accreditation Card does not imply that accredited media can access all areas for interviews; special areas, such as photo positions and SMC at venues of opening and closing ceremonies, will require additional access controls, such as photo vests, media passes, special passes for the opening and closing ceremonies, and tickets.

6.1.1.2 Guest Pass and Upgrade Card

There is one type of guest pass available, the MMC/IBC Guest Pass. It is for non-accredited persons who are invited to visit MMC/IBC. When this pass is used, the pass holder must be accompanied by a person from the inviting or processing party at all times

There is one type of upgrade card that varies in design based on the venue where the upgrade card is used, such as competition venues, TWG Village, and MMC/IBC, and must be used in





conjunction with the Accreditation Card.

6.1.1.3 Loss, Theft, or Damage of Accreditation Card

In the event of the loss, theft, or damage of an Accreditation Card, accredited media must promptly visit the Media Accreditation Centre at MMC to apply for a replacement. The person reporting the loss must complete the Problem Handling Form and present a valid identity document. If the photo or personal information on the Accreditation Card is unclear to the point of being unrecognisable or if the access unrecognisable or if the access control system cannot read the card, the cardholder should visit the Media Accreditation Centre to replace the Accreditation Card.





6.3 Transportation

The following transportation services will be provided for accredited media (Transportation Code: TM) during TWG 2025 Chengqıı.

- ·Arrival and departure transportation services between the Recommended Media Hotels and Chengdu Tianfu International Airport, Chengdu Shuangliu International Airport, and Chengdudong Railway Station;
- ·Transportation services for the opening and closing ceremonies between the venues of opening and closing ceremonies and MMC;
- ·Shuttle services between Tianfu International Hotel Complex (Rongxiu Courtyard and Rongya Courtyard) and MMC;
- ·Shuttle services between MMC Shuttle Bus Station and TWG Village Zone B Shuttle Bus Station: departing every 15 minutes (peak period) or every 45 minutes (off-peak period);
- ·Games-time transportation services between competition venues and MMC and TWG Village Zone B;
- ·Shuttle buses travelling to and from between MMC and TWG Plaza.

6.4 Accommodation

6.6 Technology

6.6.1 Technical Support Hotline

A Technical Services Desk is set up on the first floor of MMC, primarily responsible for addressing technical issues such as Wi-Fi connection and printing.

6.6.2 Games-time Communications Services

Mobile networks available in the Chinese mainland include 5G (NR TDD) and 4G (TD-LTE and FDD-LTE). These networks cover all competition venues, venues of opening and closing ceremonies, TWG Village, MMC, IBC, and other venues and event sites. Reliable mobile communications services are available for the media as long as they have mobile terminals compatible with the above-mentioned networks and valid UIM or SIM cards. Overseas participants that need to use their own SIM cards must ensure their mobile phones are compatible with the above-mentioned mobile networks and that their service providers have roaming services in China and the roaming services have been activated.

6.6.3 Games-time Internet Services

During TWG 2025 Chengdu, free wired and wireless internet access will be provided in the media areas for accredited media. The internet service provided by Chengdu ExCo will feature a shared bandwidth for a venue





6.6.4 Instructions for Wired Internet Connection:

Step 1: Connect the Ethernet cable to your device at MMC or any competition or non-competition venue, which will automatically obtain an IP.

Step 2: A Web authentication page pops up. Enter your username and password. You will gain access to the Internet once your identity is verified.

Note: After a successful first-time login, you can access the wired Internet connection in MMC and any competition or non-competition venue with the same device without repeating the authentication process.

6.6.5 Instructions for Wireless Internet Connection:

Step 1: Within the Wi-Fi coverage in MMC or any competition or non-competition venue, find the SSID of the Wi-Fi connection, and enter the Wi-Fi password to connect.

Step 2: A Web authentication page pops up. Enter your username and password. You will gain access to the Internet once your identity is verified.

Note: After a successful first-time login, you can access the Wi-Fi connection in MMC and any competition or non-competition venue with the same device without being required to repeat the authentication process.

6.6.6 Radio Frequency Management

Domestic and overseas users who need to set up and use radio stations and radio transmitting equipment in venues and special control areas shall submit an application for the "Radio Frequency License for The World Games 2025 Chengdu" ("Frequency License") via the official TWG 2025 Chengdu email address for frequency application (Frequency Application @theworldgames 2025. com). If foreign heads of states, foreign embassies and consulates





in China, and other overseas users with diplomatic privileges and immunity need to use radio frequencies and radio transmitting equipment, they shall submit an application to the Radio Regulation Bureau of the Ministry of Industry and Information Technology (MIIT) for approval through diplomatic channels.

Users who have obtained the Frequency License shall bring the radio stations and radio transmitting equipment to the designated inspection point for inspection before use. The inspection time and place and the way to make an appointment will be released on the official website of TWG 2025 Chengdu. For equipment inconvenient to move around, the user can make an appointment for on-site inspection. The radio stations and radio transmitting equipment that are qualified in the inspection shall be used in the venues and special control areas only when they are issued and tagged with the "Special Tag for Radio Transmitting Equipment of The World Games 2025 Chengdu". Such stations and equipment must be operated in accordance with the area, time and technical indicators specified in the Frequency License.





7 Useful Information

7.1 Power and Sockets

The standard mains electricity supply voltage in China is 220V (50Hz), with the commonly used sockets being two-pin flat or three-pin flat.

7.2 Measurement System

China uses the metric system. Distances are measured in kilometres, with road speed limits displayed in kilometres per hour. Weight is measured in kilograms, and petrol is sold by the litre. Temperature is measured in degrees Celsius.

7.4 Tipping

In China, there is no customary practice of tipping; therefore, the amount shown on the bill is the exact amount to be paid. Some restaurants may include a fixed percentage service charge on the bill.

7.5 Currency and Payment Methods

The currency of China is the Renminbi (CNY), with amount shown in yuan. Most banks in China provide foreign currency exchange services. Currency exchange machines are available on the first floor of MMC. Credit card payments are accepted in Chengdu.

7.6 Medical Services

Medical services, including on-site treatment and emergency transfer, will be provided to all accredited media at competition/non-competition venues and venues of opening and closing ceremonies during TWG 2025 Chengdu.

In the event of an accident or sudden illness requiring urgent medical assistance during TWG 2025 Chengdu, you can call China's emergency help line "120", inform the dispatcher of your accreditation category/status, precise location, and medical condition. Professional rescue personnel will respond promptly.

The hospitals for TWG 2025 Chengdu include nearby and referral hospitals. All of them have green channels and reserved beds to provide medical services for accredited persons.




